What to Bring

Copy of birth certificate: Needed if your child wasn't registered with White Bear Soccer Club for Summer 2007.

Emergency information: Doctor and dentist's names, addresses, phone, and health insurance policy numbers

Any adult working with a team (manager, coach – ALL AGES) must be registered! Registration info will be available at wbsoccer.org and during registration.

Uniforms: For Summer 2008 – new travel uniforms. **All U9 – U16 travel players MUST purchase the new uniform.** Know your player's sizes or bring your player with you. Under-17 and older players should check with their team management on their plan. Uniforms may be purchased during online registration.

PLAYERS AND PROGRAMS

The White Bear Soccer Club takes great pride in providing everyone – from U5 to U19, Premier to Classic 3 – a place to play summer soccer. The season typically begins with practices in April and games from mid-May through July. Coaching equipment bags are available for U5 – U10 teams. Teams are formed within these divisions:

Micro Soccer (3 v 3, no keeper) introduces the Under-5 and Under-6 players and coaches to the sport. Girls and boys have separate leagues. Games are played on weeknights.

Under-7 and Under-8 expands on the skills development program with a 5 v 5 (4 field players & a keeper) league.

Under-9 and Under-10 WBSC Recreation League teams will play 6 v 6 against other White Bear teams.

Under-11/Under-12 and Under-13/Under-14 Rec+ teams play their games in the travel format but against teams within the club and, maybe, neighboring clubs. No tryouts for this program. This is a great option for kids who love soccer but don't want to participate in the travel program.

Under-9 and Under-10 traveling teams expand their soccer horizons by playing teams from other communities for the first time. Teams are divided by skill level with the U9s and U10s playing 6 v 6 small sided games in Maroon or Gold divisions.

Under-11 through Under-19 teams are competitive. Teams are formed by tryouts and play in MYSA divisions, divided by skill level.

Under 18/19 Tournament-Only Teams : Players at this age often find it difficult to commit to a summer of league play. Tournament-only teams are comprised of players that do not compete in league play but can play in summer tournaments.

FALL SOCCER PROGRAM

The White Bear Soccer Club sponsors MYSA traveling teams for Under-9 through Under-14 age levels. Games are played on weekends. The White Bear Lake Area School District Community Services and Recreation Department also provides programs for K – 6 grades in the fall. Registration deadline for WBSC MYSA teams is Aug 1, 2008. The cost is \$60.

PARENTS: A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN
